Emeritus Professor of Dermatology, University of Manchester, Adjunct Professor, King's College London and a Consultant Dermatologist, King's College Hospital.

Qualified in medicine from St Thomas' Hospital Medical School and trained in dermatology in London and Michigan.

In 1994 appointed to the Foundation Chair in Dermatology at the University of Manchester and founded the Manchester Dermatopharmacology Unit and the Manchester Psoriasis Service.

Has received many national and international awards for his work including OBE "for services to dermatology" in the 2018 Queen's New Year Honours.

An NIHR Emeritus Senior Investigator and a Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences.

Former President of the European Society for Dermatological Research, the European Dermatology Forum, the British Association of Dermatologists, and the International Psoriasis Council, which he co-founded in 2004.

Editor-in-Chief of Rook's Textbook of Dermatology and Rook's Dermatology Handbook.

Active in global health initiatives, including directing the Global Psoriasis Atlas, co-founding the Burma Skincare Initiative charity and acting as advisor on global health research and policy to the International League of Dermatological Societies.

Chris runs international courses on art appreciation for clinicians.
