Main field of interest is the diagnosis and treatment of inflammatory skin diseases.

In 2013, completed a two-years fellowship at the Laboratory for Investigative Dermatology at the Rockefeller University, New York, NY. with Prof. J Krueger. During her fellowship, focused on psoriasis, metabolic syndrome, and imaging such as PET/CT, sono-elastography and CT angiography, in the diagnosis of psoriatic patients.

In January 2021, completed her PhD in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology with a thesis entitled: "Results of two different biological treatment in patients with PsO and PsA, and detection of early arthritis".

Current research includes projects on biological agents for the treatment of psoriasis and atopic dermatitis, laser and cosmetology. She is also involved in numerous phase III clinical trials and is author of many papers on this topic.

Completed 3 years of research at the University of Rome Tor Vergata from 2018 to 2021. Resident at the University of "Rome Tor Vergata" from 2012 to 2017.

Member of the "Italian task force" for women with psoriasis, member of the Italian Society of Dermatology and Venereology (SIDeMaST), member of the European Academy of Dermatology and Venereology (EADV), member of International Dermoscopy Society (IDS), member of Association of Dermatology of Magna Grecia (ADMG) and member of the local organizing committee for the World Congress of Dermatology 2019 Milan, Italy.

Dr Dattola is also Secretary General for the next International Congress of Dermatology (ICD) that will be held in Rome in June 2025.
