Dr. Vera is an Associate Professor of Dermatology and Immunodermatologist at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile, Santiago, Chile.

He received his Medical Degree and completed his dermatology residency at the Dermatology Department, School of Medicine at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile. He finished his fellowship in Immunodermatology at the Department of Dermatology and Skin Science at the University of British Columbia, Vancouver, Canada.

Dr. Vera became the Program Director of the Dermatology Program at the School of Medicine at Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile in 2017-2021 and President of the Chilean Society of Dermatology and Venereology in 2020-2022. He has been a member of the American Academy of Dermatology since 2008 and the American College of Rheumatology since 2011.

Dr. Vera is an Author of more than 55 articles indexed in Pubmed on autoimmune diseases, such as lupus, Dermatomyositis, and skin manifestations of Rheumatic Diseases. He is also the Author of several chapters in international books such as "X Wortsman Textbook of Dermatologic Ultrasound," "Hertl M. Autoimmune Diseases of the Skin," "Lahita R. Systemic Lupus Erythematosus," and "Da Costa Minimally Invasive Aesthetic Procedures: A Guide for Dermatologists and Plastic Surgeons."
